**Emergency Medical Responder (EMR)**

This course provides the knowledge and skills required in an emergency to help sustain life, reduce pain, and minimize the consequences of injury or sudden illness in a prehospital setting. This course is for those providing an emergency response including Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel, Fire Fighters, Law Enforcement, and workplace responders. Includes CPR and AED for Healthcare Providers. To practice as an EMR you are required to be registered with the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics.

**Dates:** \*this course requires a minimum of 4 people\* possible dates can be discussed with the First Aid/CPR Coordinator

**Times:** All courses begin at 0900hrs

**Location:** 1072 103<sup>rd</sup> Street, North Battleford, SK (if location changes, customer will be notified of change promptly)

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Approximate Course Length: 80-120 hours

Prerequisites: Standard 1<sup>st</sup> Aid with CPR Level "C"; pre-course assignment

**Certification:** 3 year certification in Emergency Medical Responder, CPR Level HCP and AED

100% attendance, skills demonstration, 80% minimum passing grade on written exam and one evaluated scenario
