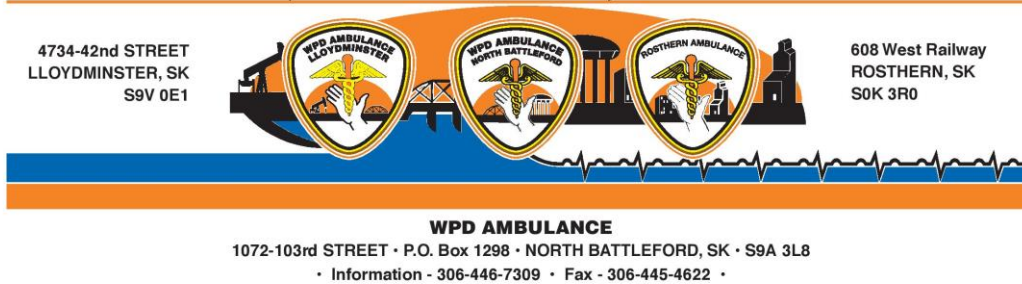


"Recipients of the 2012 BBEX Community Contribution Award"



First Responder

This course teaches pre-hospital care and CPR skills for people who want to become First Responders in their communities. This course includes techniques for sustaining life, preventing further injuries, and caring for illnesses and injuries until the next level of medical care arrives. This course includes CPR and AED for Healthcare Providers

Dates: *this course requires a minimum of 4 people* possible dates can be discussed with the First Aid/CPR Coordinator

Times: All courses begin at 0900hrs

Location: 1072 103rd Street, North Battleford, SK (if location changes, customer will be notified of change promptly.)

Approximate Course Length: 80 hours

Prerequisite: CPR level "C"

Certification: 3 year certification in First Responder, CPR Level HCP and AED

100% attendance, skills demonstration, 80% minimum passing grade on written exam and one evaluated scenario
